WHAT ARE WE DOING?

We are going to be using **ZOOM**



ZOOM is a video conferencing program to make this possible. Below is a video detailing the process and how classes will be set up, as well as what the students will need on their end to make the process run smoothly.

WHAT ARE STUDENTS GOING TO NEED?



- Internet connection and device (iPad/Computer)
- Speakers/Headphones audio to hear the class
- A working keyboard of some form to use a chatbox.

IS YOUR STUDENT STUDYING MATH WITH US?

We will have online math classes using a separate platform called Newrow. This conferencing program is similar to ZOOM, however it has a more math friendly interface, as well as additional tools (whiteboards, file uploading capabilities, etc.). Newrow operates in the same fashion as ZOOM, in that, before the class, it provides you with a link that takes you directly to your room.



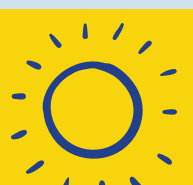
ANSWERS TO SOME QUESTIONS YOU MAY HAVE...

HOW TO PLAY ONLINE!

In order to keep classes as close to normal as possible we require that all students create a **chess.com** account to play games with during class!

You can do this for free!



INSTRUCTIONS

1

Go to **chess.com** and go through their sign-up process creating a username and password etc.

2

After that, send the username via email to **diana@icanj.net** so we can add the account to our ICA club on chess.com

3

After sending us the username you can find the club invite in your message inbox, to get there, go to the **chess.com** homepage, hover over the home tab on the left sidebar and click messages. Accept the club invite from there.

To challenge another member of the club, hover over the "Connect" tab on the left sidebar, click clubs, then click the **ICA club**.

Once in the ICA club, on the right sidebar click the "Members" option. This will take you to a list of all the players in the club. From there you can challenge anyone of them using the icon of a board with a "+" sign on it
