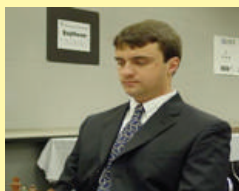
## GRAND MASTER-LEVEL TRAINING SUMMER PROGRAM

### Grandmaster Alex Chernin (FIDE Senior Trainer)

Former world championship candidate and Soviet co-champion Alex Chernin is a world-renowned chess coach and author. His coaching prowess can be seen in the recent victories of tree of his students: Fabiano Caruana (now number 5 in the world!), Kayden Troff (world U14 Champion!), and Samuel Sevian (world U12 Champion!). He is also the author of the highly popular Pirc Alert.



### Grandmaster Alex Stripunsky

Alex Stripunsky is one of America's top Grandmasters and frequent US Championship contender. His recent tournament victories include: 2005 US Championship (tied for first), 2007 World Open (tied for 1st), 2010 Philadelphia Open (tied for 1st), 2010 Eastern Chess Congress (tied for 1st), 2008 and 2012 Continental Open (clear 1st). Alex is teaching Master Class at ICA. He is a co-founder of Mid South Chess [www.chesscamp.us](http://www.chesscamp.us)



### Grandmaster Tamaz Gelashvili

Tamaz Gelashvili is Georgian men champion of 2000 and member of Georgian National Team from 1999 (he played in 4 chess Olympiads). Tamaz won a very impressive number of US tournaments: Philadelphia Open 2011, US Open 2011, NY International 2012, Boardwalk Open 2012, Liberty Bell Open 2013, NY International 2013, World open 2013, Continental open 2013.



### Grandmaster Sergey Kudrin

Sergey Kudrin has competed in top-level chess tournaments for decades and has quite a bit of knowledge to impart to students. Sergey was twice a member of USA Olympic team. His most recent tournament successes include: 2011 US Senior Open (clear 1st), 2011 Western States Open (clear 1st), won Gran Prix in 2011, 2012 Long Island Open (tied for 1st), 2012 Northeast Open (clear 1st) and North East Open 2013 (clear 1st).
